Originally developed for the US Navy, the F-4 twin-engined supersonic long-range fighter-bomber first flew in the spring of 1958. It entered service for the US Navy in 1961, and the UK Fleet Air Arm and RAF in 1969. Regarded as one of the most versatile fighters ever built, the Phantom F-4 was the US Navy's fastest and highest-flying aircraft. It was flown by both US military demonstration teams from 1969 to 1973, and ended its service in 1991 with the RAF, although continues to serve a variety of air forces across the world.

Richard Pike who joined the Royal Air Force in August 1961, flew the English Electric Lightning before converting to the McDonnell Douglas F-4 Phantom. He lives in Aberdeenshire.

Dr. Graham Powell's new work builds on his earlier publication, *Lives of Conifers: A Comparative Account of the Coniferous Trees*. As in the previous book, Dr. Powell provides his readers with a detailed view of the morphological and physiological features of the Canadian broadleaved species birch, maple, and ironwood. These species occur naturally in one or more of the four Atlantic Provinces, in Québec, east of Québec City in Canada, and in the states of Maine, New Hampshire and Vermont in the United States.

Powell's approach offers readers unique overviews of the complex and dynamic features of tree growth, reproduction and physical development. His text is profusely illustrated and researched and amply supported by full citations for all scholarly work quoted.

Dr. Graham R. Powell is Professor Emeritus in the Faculty of Forestry and Environmental management at the University of New Brunswick. He is the author of numerous technical reports and handbooks, and directed the Faculty's Graduate Studies Programme for ten years. He lives in Fredericton, NB.

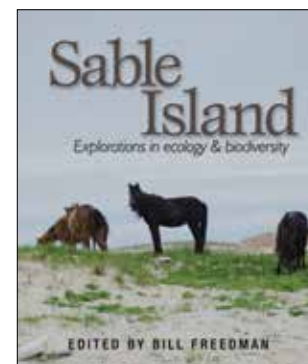

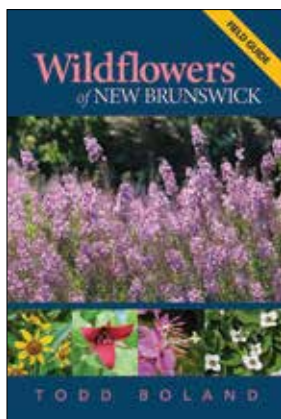

Sable Island is a storied place. This remote, 50-km-long, emergent sandbar, located at the very edge of the continental shelf off Nova Scotia, has been the locale of hundreds of tragic shipwrecks, brave rescues of stranded mariners, and home to many thousands of seals and hundreds of wild horses. It was because of its famous natural and historical features that Sable Island was made a new national park of Canada in 2013. From this freshly conferred status, there emerged a need to develop a management plan for the island, to ensure that its key natural features would be conserved. Profusely illustrated with photographs, line drawings, and tables, the book also provides prudent recommendations for the ongoing research and stewardship of Sable Island.

Professor **William Freedman**, former head of Dalhousie University's Biology Department, chaired the Nature Conservancy of Canada's Board of Directors, in addition to being an active member of the Tree Canada Foundation. Awarded the Canadian Geographic Society's Gold Medal Environment Award, he is the author of several books, including *Environmental Science*, and *Ecology: a Canadian Context*, in addition to being the editor of *Encyclopedia of Endangered Species*.

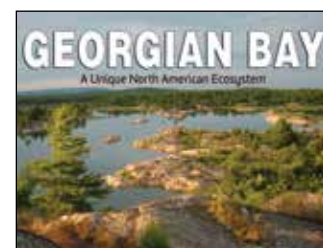
Georgian Bay

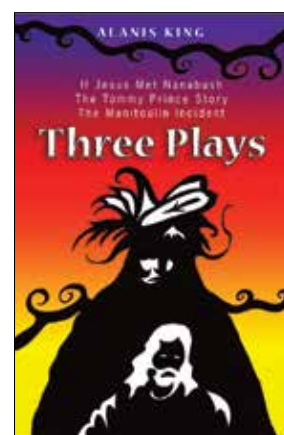
If Jesus Met Nanabush, the Tommy Prince Story, Manitoulin Incident

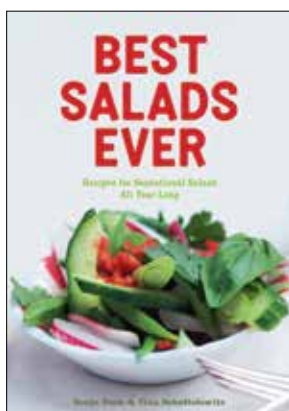


Edible Herbs and Wild Plants

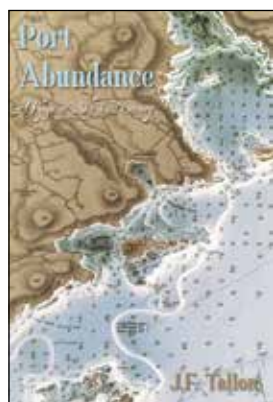


The Roar of the Sea
