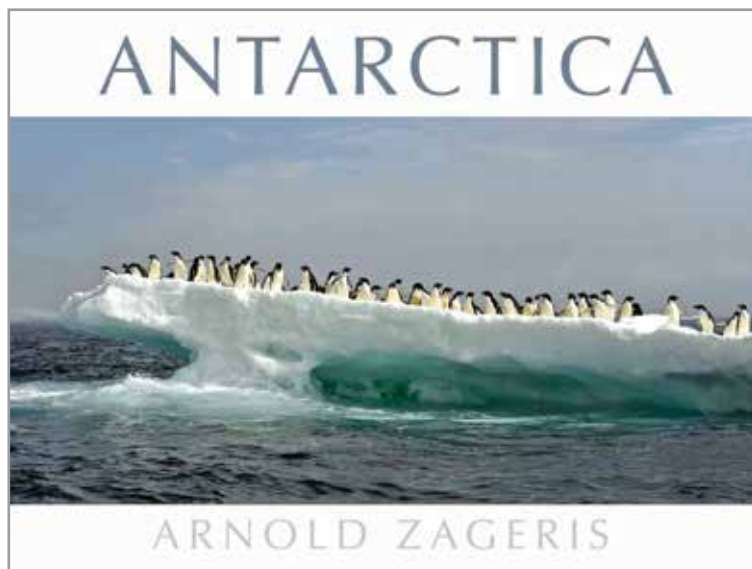
## THE SAINTS OF THE LOST AND FOUND

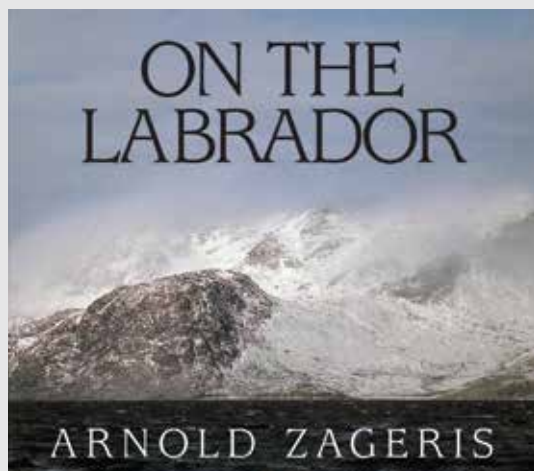

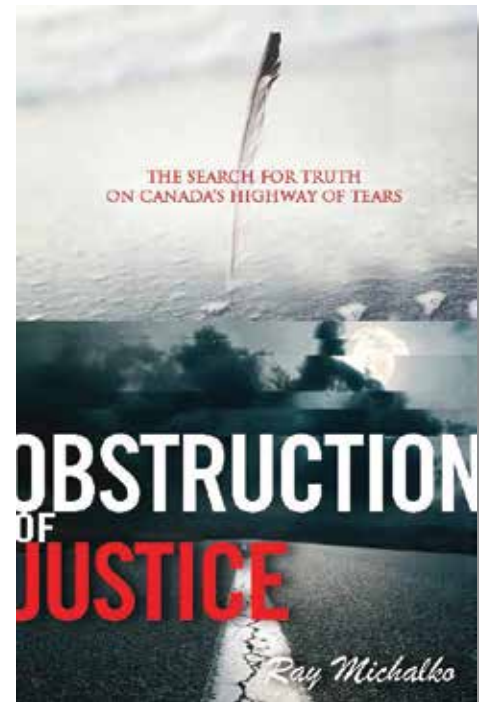
## OBSTRUCTION OF JUSTICE (HIGHWAY OF TEARS)

Ray Michalko explores the series of unsolved murdered and missing women's cases in northern British Columbia, along a lonely seven hundred kilometer stretch of Highway 16, now known as "The Highway of Tears" that winds its way through the scenic wilderness of the Coast Mountains, west from Prince George, through a number of small northern communities to Prince Rupert, on northern British Columbia's West Coast. The Highway of Tears holds the secrets of multiple mysteries spanning close to four decades and the tragic unknown sets of circumstances involving the murder and disappearance of nine young women, all an average age of eighteen and with one exception, all Aboriginal.

Fueled by frustration with the police's inability to solve any of these crimes in thirty-five years, inspired by the belief that someone somewhere knew something, and driven by his unexplainable personal commitment, Ray embarked on a life altering journey.

RAY MICHALKO is an ex-member of the RCMP, who chose to leave honorably after the completion of nine years' service, despite having been told that he was being considered for promotion to Corporal. Ray is currently a licensed Private Investigator in British Columbia, an associate member of the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners, and has owned and operated a small private investigation company since 2001. 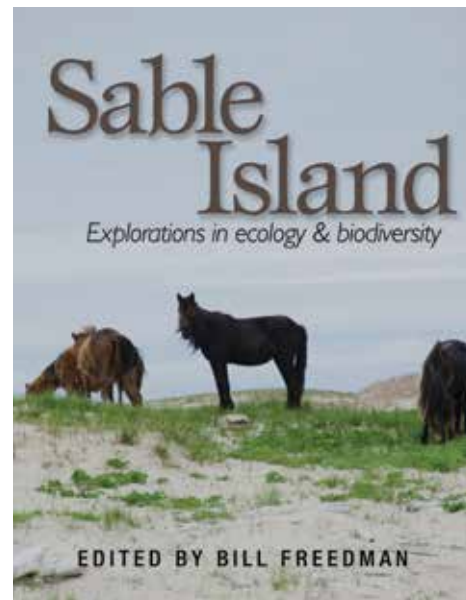
## SABLE ISLAND

*Sable Island* is a storied place. This remote, 50-km-long, emergent sandbar, located at the very edge of the continental shelf off Nova Scotia, has been the locale of hundreds of tragic shipwrecks, brave rescues of stranded mariners, and home to many thousands of seals and hundreds of wild horses.

It was because of its famous natural and historical features that Sable Island was made a new national park of Canada in 2013. From this freshly conferred status, there emerged a need to develop a management plan for the island, to ensure that its key natural features would be conserved. PROFESSOR WILLIAM FREEDMAN was the former head of Dalhousie University's Biology Department, chaired the Nature Conservancy of Canada's Board of Directors, in addition to being an active member of the Tree Canada Foundation. Awarded the Canadian Geographic Society's Gold Medal Environment Award, he was the author of several books, including *Environmental Science*, and *Ecology: a Canadian Context*, in addition to being the editor of *Encyclopedia of Endangered*.



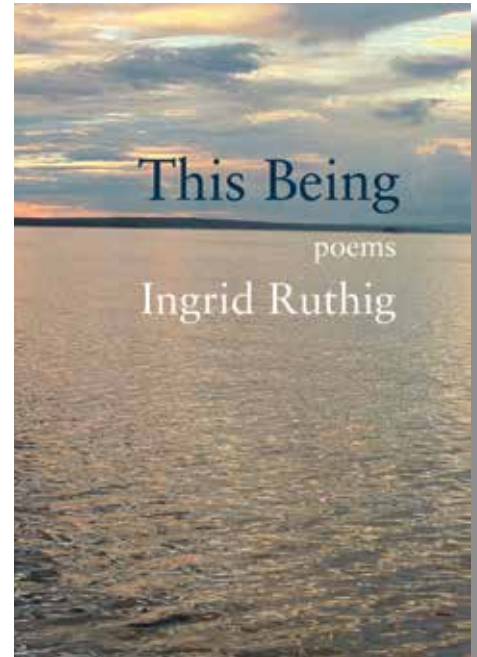

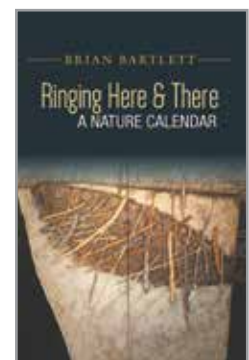

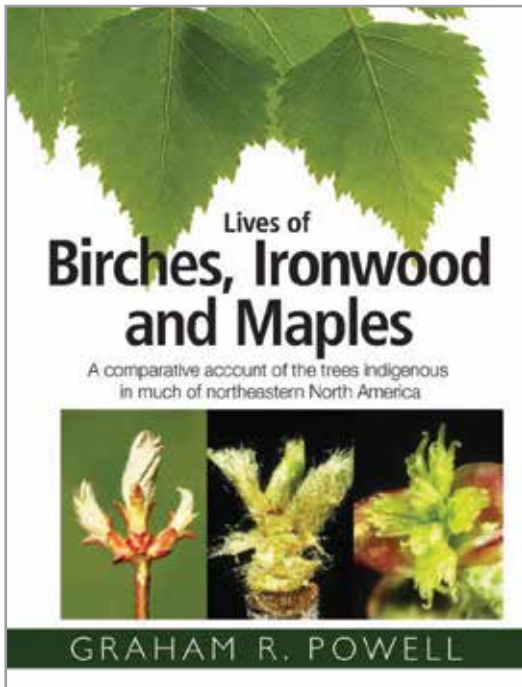

## LIVES OF BIRCHES, IRONWOOD AND MAPLES

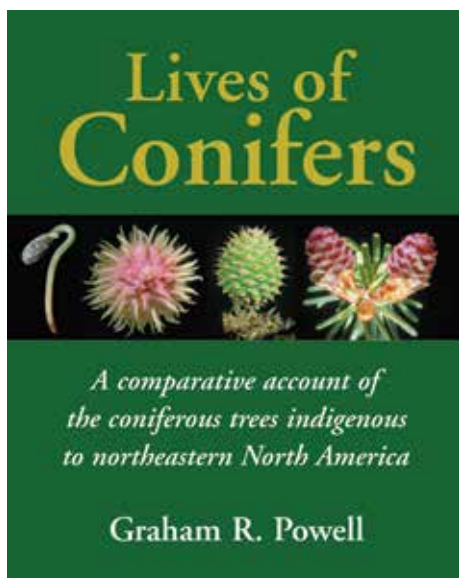
By *Graham R. Powell*

Powell's approach offers readers unique overviews of the complex and dynamic features of tree growth, reproduction and physical development. His text is profusely illustrated and researched and amply supported by full citations for all scholarly work quoted.

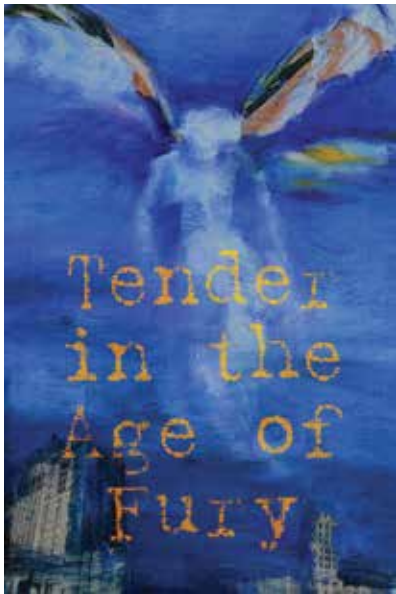
*A World We Have Lost* examines the early history of Saskatchewan through an Aboriginal and environmental lens. Indian and mixed-descent peoples played leading roles in the story—as did the land and climate. Despite the growing British and Canadian presence, the Saskatchewan country remained Aboriginal territory. The region’s peoples had their own interests and needs and the fur trade was often peripheral to their lives. Indians and Métis peoples wrangled over territory and resources, especially bison, and were not prepared to let outsiders control their lives, let alone decide their future. Native-newcomer interactions were consequently fraught with misunderstandings, sometimes painful difficulties, if not outright disputes.

By the early nineteenth century, a distinctive western society had emerged in the North-West—one that was challenged and undermined by the takeover of the region by young dominion of Canada. Settlement and development was to be rooted in the best features of Anglo-Canadian civilization, including the white race. By the time Saskatchewan entered confederation as a province in 1905, the world that Kelsey had encountered during his historic walk on the northern prairies had become a world we have lost.
