





He has been an active member of Trails BC; the Canadian Authors Association; and several other outdoor, writing and history groups. He has won awards for his writing.



These poems travel along a ragged b-line from the banks of the frozen Yukon River to the sun-blasted hinterlands of Barcelona, and all the way to the “cat’s cradle” of the ring-roads in Beijing. In *A Violent Streak*, anxiety, ritual, the inertia of family trauma, expatriatism and sexual politics collide, testing the virtue of flight, haste and distraction. Here the poet compulsively overhauls and fractures her sense of self, revealing that between blithe stabs at domesticity and endless flat shares, the “fabled Spanish light, like powdered glass, begins to wear her down...”

Stephanie Warner was born in Kamloops, and grew up in British Columbia, Alberta and the Yukon. Her poetry has appeared in the Montreal Poetry Prize Global Anthology, and was awarded second place in the 2015 Prism international poetry contest. She lives in Vancouver





N. Glenn Perrett is a writer and environmentalist who, along with his wife Lynn, has spent considerable time exploring the national parks of Southern Ontario.




Sydney Bellingham's Canada William Hesler

LAMB KOFTA W SPICED YOGURT

Serves 4, or serve at a party as an appetizer. Big bold Middle Eastern flavours without all the complicated ingredients so often required. I have a feeling this'll end up being a fave of yours, it is at my place.

- 1/2 medium white onion
- 2 garlic cloves, peeled
- 1 lb. ground lamb
- 1 Tbsp. of cumin
- 1 tsp. salt/1 tsp. pepper
- 1 cup Greek yogurt
- 2" of English cucumber, sliced
- 2 Tbsp. rough chop fresh mint (10 leaves or so)
- Crushed chili oil (to taste)

Full fat or 0%, your call


*I prefer Chinese style chili oils (with a few flakes in them)
Big flavour and not CRAZY hot*

Pulse the onion and garlic in a food processor until finely chopped (almost minced but not quite, you still want a little texture). Then, in a bowl, combine onion mixture, lamb, cumin and salt/pepper. Then roll into balls 1 1/2 inches in diameter. Letting the balls rest in the fridge for 20 min. While the meatballs are in the fridge preheat oven to 450F. Add a healthy splash of olive oil to an oven proof frying pan over high heat. Add the balls in batches to not overcrowd the pan. Fry until golden on all sides, about 1 to 2 minutes per side - turn for even browning. Remove seared meatballs onto a plate. Repeat with remaining meatballs. Add seared meatballs back into the pan and slide into the oven until cooked through, about 5 minutes. Smear yogurt on your platter, add lamb balls, cucumber, drizzle with crushed chili oil and top with mint.


Food for thought

- * This works great w ground beef or a beef and a pork combo - just don't buy too lean. It's a super lean dish anyway, don't get all "low fat" on this one.
- * I know you're thinking about making a bulk batch to freeze. Don't. They're so heavenly made fresh, and quick, so why bother?
- * The balls are awesome the next day, tossed in a pita with tomato, lettuce, onion, parsley, pickles and tzatziki. Perfect hang-over food.
- * There's lots of dishes that work just as well with ground chicken or turkey instead of lamb. But this ain't one of them! I tried, too dry and not enough richness. Don't do it.

Kwäday Dän Ts'inchí

Teachings from Long Ago Person Found

Richard J. Hebda, Sheila Greer, Alexander Mackie



On a late summer day a young man set out on a voyage through the mountains. In 1999, 300 years later, he was discovered by three hunters on the edge of a glacier in northwestern BC, near the Alaska-Yukon border. His remains, preserved in glacial ice for centuries, offered answers, setting in motion a unique multidisciplinary collaboration between indigenous peoples and the scientific community based on mutual respect.

Through forensic investigation we learn that he was 18 years old, 5' 8" tall, had a tapeworm, a gastric ulcer, and was in the early stages of tuberculosis. From the food sources found in his stomach, colon and rectum, we learned he traveled 70 km in two days. We know he died in August because flowers of the beach asparagus, found in his stomach, only bloom in August, in the area he was found.


The man's name had faded from even the long memory of the local Champagne and Aishihik indigenous peoples so they renamed him, Kwaday Dan Ts'inchí—the Long Ago Person Found.

This comprehensive and collaborative account contains contributors from around the world, interweaving scientific analysis and cultural knowledge to describe not only an individual and his world, but also a model for how diverse ways of knowing, in both scholarly and oral traditions, can complement each other to provide a new understanding of our complex histories.







The book provides an entertaining visual account of the work of Duval as she struggled and succeeded in creating a new urban visual culture.





Have you ever provided personal info like age or grade when you sign up for press online, or included a friend's email address to get an extra reward? Be careful. That's valuable information! And you don't know how it will be used—your privacy might even be at risk. Some companies gather this data to create more ads targeted at you and your friends, or even sell your private info to another company.

In Italy, people take their pizza very seriously. When McDonald's ran a video ad set in an old style Italian restaurant featuring a little boy telling the waiter he'd prefer a Happy Meal to the traditional pizza pie, the country's top pizza chefs threatened legal action. They claimed the ad was an attack on Italian cultural traditions.

A few years ago, fast food chicken chain KFC went viral with a YouTube video in which a boy shows up at a girl's house dressed for prom. He gives her a box and inside, instead of a flower, there's a greasy fried chicken leg to wear around her wrist as a corsage. The girl is surprised but thrilled. During their slow dance, she leans in toward him and instead of a kiss, she takes a bite out of her fried chicken corsage. The ad, aimed at high schoolers, got 400,000 hits on YouTube in its first week.

When Domino's opened in Nigeria in 2012, many people weren't familiar with pizza. To attract customers and spread the word, the company offered coupons: Nigerian foods as pizza toppings, including Jollof Rice, which is rice mixed with tomatoes and red peppers, and chicken Suya, a spicy stewed chicken.



Viral marketing of fast food through mobile devices has seen a huge increase in the last few years. In just one year, fast food restaurants placed six billion ads on Facebook. Taco Bell's YouTube videos were viewed almost 10 million times!

Too Good to be True

Over the last decade, people have become more aware of the connection between their health and the food they eat. Food and beverage companies have responded with tons of new products—and advertising promises.

"A great source of calcium/protein/iron."

"All natural!"

Sound familiar?

Even longstanding junk food products have been made to seem healthier. Sugary cereals announce: "Now with whole grains!" on the front of the box. Fast food restaurants list "Healthier for you" products on their menus. It would be great if it were true, but according to research from the U.S.-based Prevention Institute, more than eighty per cent of so-called healthier products offered in stores and restaurants don't meet even basic nutritional standards.

It's confusing and frustrating to sort through all the promises—especially when there's a new study each week with different advice about what we should be eating, or not eating.

So who should we believe? Sometimes the simplest advice is the best (if not the easiest to follow). Consider food writer Michael Pollan's famous words: "Eat food [meaning real whole foods like vegetables, fruit and grains]. Not too much. Mostly plants."



DO THIS!

Out of Line: Standing Up for Junk Free Checkouts

Have you ever noticed how chocolates, sweets, chips, and gum are placed near the checkout line in your local grocery store? Well, it's no accident. Grocery stores are carefully designed to encourage you to buy more stuff. All that junk by the checkout is meant to increase impulse purchases—buying on the spur of the moment when you're bored or just waiting to be served.

But nearly ninety per cent of the checkout foods aren't healthy, according to researchers in Sheffield, England. And many of them are placed at exactly the right height to get kids' interest.

For several years, British parents, with the help of the nonprofit food organization, Sustain, and the British Dietetic Association, has been trying to make the case that it isn't fair for stores to tempt kids with junk foods. After all, diet-related illnesses like diabetes and obesity are big problems in Britain, as they are elsewhere around the world, and eating too many of these foods isn't healthy for anyone.

So they created a campaign called Junk Free Checkouts that encourages customers to give pass

or fail report cards to their local stores. Fail for those who do not. Junk Free got a boost when two of the biggest grocery stores in the country, Tesco and Lidl, opted to only offer good-for-you snacks at their checkouts. Several other chains have since followed suit.



Fruit, Glorious Fruit: Playing With Your Food

Most of the food ads we see are for salty snacks, fast food, and soft drinks. But one grocery store chain in France is trying to change that. The ad is simple: a shiny green apple glistening with water droplets on a bright white background.

Only this apple is different. Really different. It has an enormous tumor-like growth coming out of the top. "A grotesque apple . . . a day keeps the doctor away as well," the ad announces.

Other images in Intermarché's cheeky advertising campaign promote the ugly carrot (with two thick roots but still great in soup), the ridiculous potato (perfect for mashing though it has bumps and nubs) and the hideous orange (delicious in juice despite a massive navel).

Many grocery stores won't accept such produce from farmers, because they believe customers won't buy it. As a result, lots of odd-looking but perfectly good food is just thrown away. Every year, about 88 million tonnes of food goes to waste in the European Union.

But shoppers at Intermarché didn't mind the ugly produce after all—especially offered at a thirty per cent discount. Buzz from the funny ads attracted new customers, who also tried juices and soups made from the fruit and veg. Intermarché sold 1.2 tonnes of the produce per store over the first two days of the campaign!


