
Lucy Maud Montgomery Collection










Budge Wilson


Shirley Woods is a naturalist and the author of a number of books about nature for children and adults. He lives in Mahone Bay, Nova Scotia.










Picture Books for Children




Explore Canada's Coasts




Juvenile Fiction




Evangeline
