



## The War of 1812




The 200<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the onset of the War of 1812 will be on June 18, 2012. In a war that lasted just under three years, there was a significant shift in the power and influence of the British in North America. Seen as a war with no clear winner, the war was finally resolved on December 14, 1814 with the Treaty of Ghent, although fighting continued on for many months due to lack of communication on the front lines.
