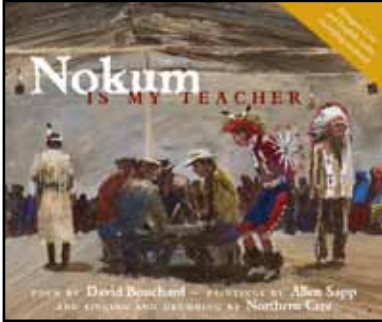


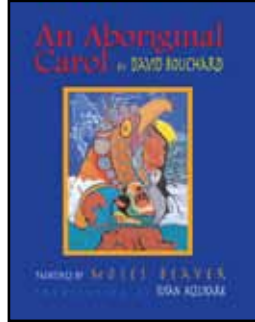
Northern Focus: Selected Books by Fitzhenry & Whiteside

Baby Polar Bear is about the early life of polar bears - born at the beginning of the arctic winter, it will be years before they are able to live on their own in the North.

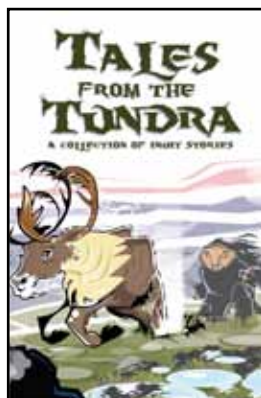
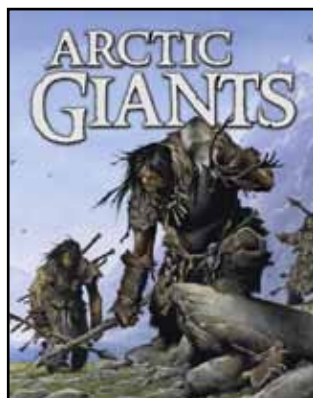
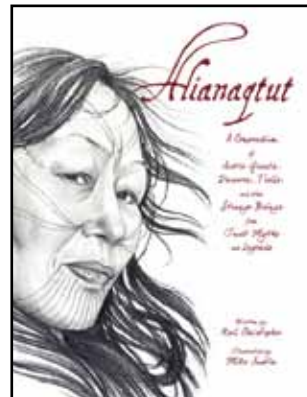
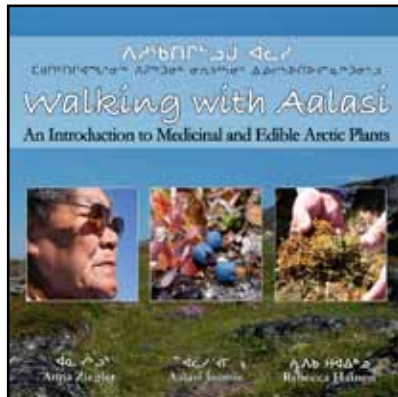
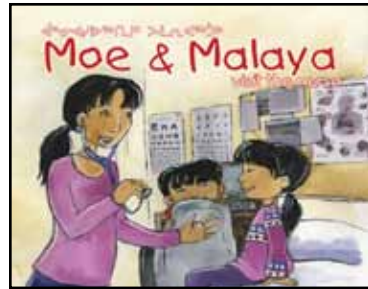
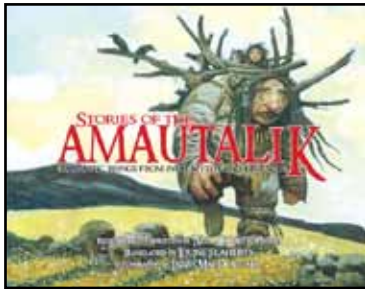
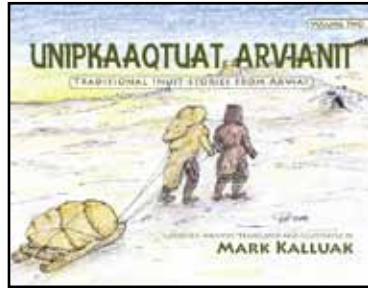
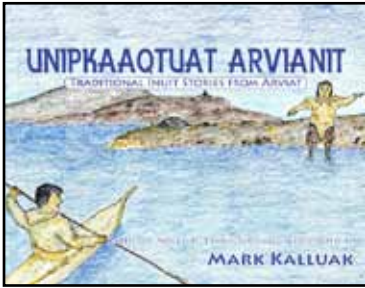
