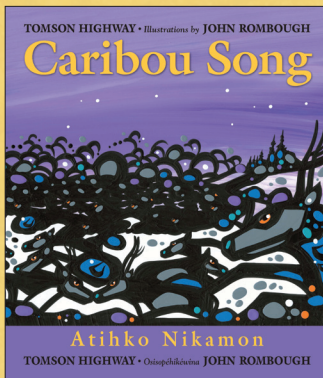

## **Caribou Song** (*Atihko Nikamon*)

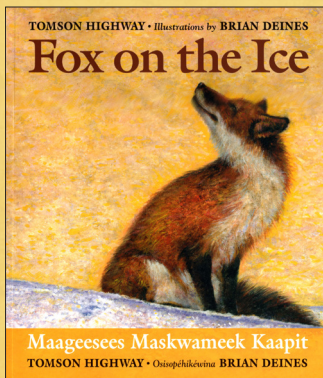
*By Tomson Highway, illustrated by John Rombough*

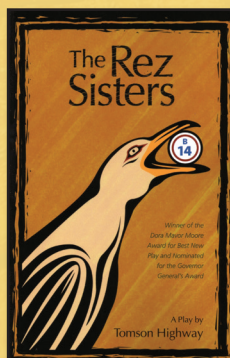

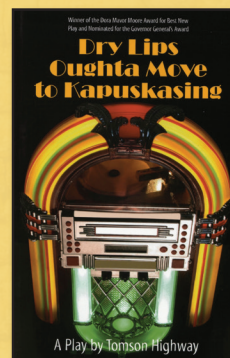
## **The Rez Sisters**

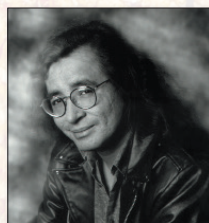
## **Dry Lips Oughta Move to Kapuskasing**
